1) Good news: Demand is there

- Sweden: website 65 000 visitors/month; 70 000 copies of book published
- England: 50% of schools consult EEF toolkit

- 2) However no easy answers:
  - Concept of knowledge
  - Context matters
  - Pay attention to process
    - aligning interests
    - mainstreaming
    - trust and partnerships



## Overarching Themes

#### 3) Unintended consequences

- Accountability frameworks
  - drives engagement, but by whom?
  - policy consequences; trade offs
  - need long-term thinking
  - impact evaluation (short or long term)?

– Do we know about what works in [brokerage]?
