
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Evidence is





"the current best knowledge" in an area.



Evidence – the current best knowledge



Broad meaning:

That a conclusion, a practice or a policy in the educational field is based on or informed by evidence means, that it is built on the most reliable, relevant and available knowledge.



Evidece – the current best knowledge

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Narrow meaning:

Evidence as it is presented in systematic research mappings and systematic reviews with a synthesis of what research is available regarding a specific area in education.

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
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Publishes systematic reviews and research mappings answering questions that politicians and practitioners in the educational field pose. It could be questions such as:

- Which teacher qualifications promote student learning?
- How can test results and data be used by teachers?

School readiness

- *
- The Ministry for children and education established 2011
- Taskforce on the whole pre-school area
- Ministry ordered a systematic reserach mapping and a state of the field portrait in 12 countries.



Reform of the vocational education system

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- ❖ DEA a Danish think tank established a commission
- ❖DEA a systematic research mapping
- The results were used to start new research projects
- ❖The results will be used when the commissions report is officially delivered May 20 th 2014.

Evidence on inclusion

- *
- August 2012 new amendment introduced regarding special needs education
- The Ministry of Education ordered a systematic reveiw to examine exsisting research on inclusion
- Resulted in: two publications, several lectures, aps, e-books and new research projects
- ❖2013 a new law was introduced where the goal is that by 2015 96% og all students in primary school and lower secondary will go to school, at their local school.



Reform of the Danish school system 2014



- New Danish school reform: A longer school day, all children should learn more, different ways of teaching and all students must thrive more
- ❖Six systematic research mappings
- ❖Six prctices publications
- ❖New teaching consultants will be taught how to use results
- ❖ Several lectures will be given across the country.



Three dilemmas to consider when "translating" research results into the field of education

- Recipies for teaching No translation at all
- Simplified results Indefinite recommendations
